

Facility Type Definitions

Public/Parks & Recreation - A facility that is open to the public on a fee-based or non-fee-based basis. It is generally operated as a municipal facility controlled by the city or paid for by public funds (i.e. YMCA's). Many Public/ Parks & Recreation facilities have a non-profit status.

School, College, University – An academy or tennis program that is attached to a grade school, middle school, high school, college, or university. It is not necessary run by the school, college, or university.

Commercial Facility – A business operation open to the public that includes tennis as a main activity or part of a traditional health club and charges for court use and programming. (i.e. Midtown, Five Seasons, Life Fitness, Club Corp tennis facilities).

Private/Accepts non-members - A private facility which will also allow outside membership or daily participation on a restricted basis.

Private Member Only - A facility within a private community that only accepts memberships from its property owners. Does not accept outside member participation or memberships.

Resort - A vacation destination facility that generally serves the tourist trade but may be open to the public for a separate fee.
